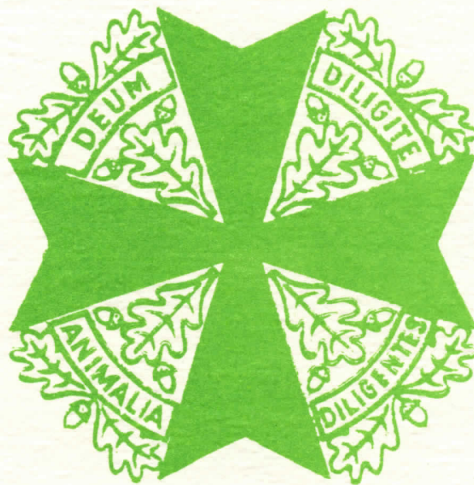

As the congregation is being seated
the **BAND OF THE SIXTH UNITED STATES ARMY** shall play
director, Sgt. Major Ronald Corey

As the DEAN'S procession enters the Cathedral
all shall stand as the Band plays

FAITH OF OUR FATHERS, St. Catherine

Then shall be sounded:
A FANFARE — Jerry Nowak
The Herald Trumpeters of the **SIXTH ARMY BAND**

After which the Pipe Band shall lead the **COLOR GUARD OF HONOR**
and **THE GRAND MASTER'S** *procession into the Cathedral*

When all have reached their appointed places
there shall be played by the **SIXTH ARMY BAND**
THE NATIONAL ANTHEMS of
THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA **GREAT BRITAIN**
AUSTRIA **CANADA**

The **GRAND MASTER** shall then receive, **THE STAFF** and **THE SCEPTRE**
of the Order and place them on the High Altar

THE INVOCATION and PRAYERS — The Very Reverend the Dean

GREETINGS — The Grand Master of the Order of Saint Hubert

THE INVESTITURE OF THE KNIGHT OFFICERS AND THE KNIGHT COMMANDER OFFICERS

*The Recipients will move in their appointed order towards the Transept.
Each recipient will be named by the Recorder as each is to be invested
with the Order's Insignia for the grade designated.*

The Recorder:

Confreere, I present to you these Knight Officers and Knight Commander Officers
for the honor of being invested in accordance with the Statutes of our Order.

The Grand Master:

With pleasure do I welcome these newly appointed and promoted Members of the Order.
By authority delegated to me, I am about to invest you Knight Officers and Knight Commander
Officers in the Venerable Order of Saint Hubert. The Badge symbolizes the Virtue of the Order
— — honor the Lord in His creatures.

*As the Knights are being invested the Pipe Major, William S. Cathro
shall play — "FLOWERS OF THE FOREST."*

The GRAND MASTER shall say to each Knight as he is being invested.

Do you agree to abide by the Constitution of the International Order of Saint Hubert?
Do you further agree to aid in the promoting of Wildlife Conservation?
By virtue of the authority vested in me and on behalf of this Venerable Order
I do invest you with the Insignia of Knight Officer (Knight Commander Officer) and welcome you
as a member of the International Order of Saint Hubert.

*At the conclusion of the Investiture the Knights shall make their
reverences to the GRAND MASTER and return to their appointed places.*

Then, all kneeling, the DEAN EMERITUS shall say.

Preserve all our Members, enlighten
Their minds that they may study to maintain
The Honor and Purpose of this Venerable Order
And give them Grace, that they may accomplish those ends. Amen
